

Executive Education Programmes

EOI FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS for working professionals

aim

The aim of this award is to encourage the participation of working professionals with solid careers in the various EOI Escuela de Organización Industrial master programmes, executive programmes or advanced courses.

beneficiaries

The scholarships are aimed at working professionals 5 years of professional experience who want to extend their professional development an EOI Business School executive education programme and **prove they have insufficient financial resources.**

documentation to be provided

1. The duly completed application form
2. A photocopy of the previous year's tax return Any foreign applicants who prove they cannot provide the requested documentation may substitute this with a sworn statement of the applicant's financial situation
3. The candidate's CV
4. A certified photocopy of the university degree certificate
5. A covering letter from the candidate detailing compliance with the award's requirements and the reasons that justify submitting the application, expressly stating how the candidate intends to fund the programme
6. 2 written references from the candidate's professional environment
7. Any other documentation that the candidate deems appropriate

amount

The amount of these scholarships varies between a minimum of 10% and a maximum of 30% of the programme's tuition fees, excluding the amount for reserving the place.

The Scholarship Committee will address the following criteria when determining whether to award the requested scholarship or not and, if the application is successful, the amount to be paid:

1. Level of income and economic circumstances of the household
2. The candidate's career
3. The results obtained during the admission process
4. Any other academic or professional merit and personal circumstances proved by the candidate

The Scholarship and Admissions Committee's decision will be on a competitive basis.

Executive Education Programmes

EXECUTIVE MBA SCHOLARSHIPS aimed at Female Executives

aim

The aim of this award is to encourage the participation of professional women with strong academic records and high leadership potential in the EOI Escuela de Organización Executive MBA Industrial Organisation programmes in order to encourage the presence of women in managerial positions.

beneficiaries

Scholarships are aimed at professional women, university graduates (BA/BSc Honours graduates) with brilliant academic records who want to complete their professional development by carrying out an Executive MBA Master from EOI Escuela de Organización Industrial.

documentation to be provided

1. The duly completed application form
2. A photocopy of the university degree certificate
3. The candidate's CV
4. A photocopy of the previous year's tax return
Any foreign students who prove they cannot provide the requested documentation may substitute this with a sworn statement of the applicant's financial situation
5. A covering letter from the candidate detailing compliance with the award's requirements and the reasons that justify submitting the application, expressly stating how the candidate intends to fund the programme.
6. 2 written references from the candidate's professional or academic environment
7. Any other supplementary documentation that the candidate deems appropriate

amount

EOI Foundation will award 6 scholarships to women in managerial positions for 50% of the costs of enrolling in the programme, minus the amount required to reserve the place.

The Scholarship Committee will address the following criteria when determining whether to award the requested scholarship or not and, if the application is successful, the amount to be paid:

1. The candidate's academic record
2. The results obtained during the admission process
3. Any other professional merits and personal circumstances proved by the candidate

The Scholarship and Admissions Committee's decision will be on a competitive basis.

Executive Education Programmes

EOI TRAVEL GRANT for working professionals

aim

The aim of this award is to assist candidates who are not residents of Madrid or Seville (headquarters of EOI-Escuela de Organización Industrial) with the travel expenses incurred as a result of their place of residence.

beneficiaries

The scholarships are aimed at working professionals who are not residents of Madrid or Seville with over five years of professional experience and have been admitted to any of the EOI Escuela de Organización Industrial Executive Education classroom-based programmes.

documentation to be provided

1. The duly completed application form
2. Certification the candidate is on the electoral register attesting their place of habitual residence. The registration date must be before the date the selection process is carried out
3. A photocopy of the previous year's tax return
4. Any other supporting documentation to justify the additional costs incurred as a result of the travel entailed to adequately follow the course

amount

EOI Foundation will award 20 travel grants for 10% of the costs of enrolling in the programme, minus the amount required to reserve the place.

The Scholarship and Admissions Committee's decision will be on a competitive basis.
